



I am the Children's Casting Director for Sir Cameron Mackintosh's production of MISS SAIGON which is touring around the UK and Ireland and coming to the Bradford Alhambra from September 17 for a few weeks.

There is a young child in this production who is completely integral to the show although he doesn't speak, dance, or sing. The child - Tam - is a boy but is often played by a girl. The most important thing is that Tam must look SE Asian. No previous experience is required. The child must be about 5 years old, small (under 117cms) and cute. They must not look like schoolchildren but have that slightly post toddler look.

We are looking for a number of children that live locally to play on a rota. The show performs Monday to Saturday evenings at 7.30 with two shows on a Wednesday or Thursday and Saturday at 2.30 and 7.30. We do not like the children to do two shows in one day if we can avoid it and we will try to cast enough children so that the performances are quite spread out. We do not want to overtire our Tams. The children have a fantastic time and the adult cast love working with them.

The children receive a performance payment and a payment for each rehearsal. They are very integral to MISS SAIGON and receive the biggest cheer at the curtain call! I will be auditioning in Bradford soon - we have a lovely time in the auditions and we find out the things we need to know through play.
